

POWER WHEELS RULES

- All children must be accompanied by a legal parent or guardian. No Exceptions.
- Only one (1) legal parent or guardian is permitted in the Pit Area. All other family members and friends must be seated in the Grandstand Area.
- Any regular electric Power Wheel is permitted. (No 4-Wheeler, Tractor or Motorcycle type are not permitted.) Child's legs must inside the Power Wheel. (This is to be a "ride in" not "ride on" Power Wheel.)
- Power Wheel Derby is for children ages 4 – 9 years old.
- All Power Wheels must remain as they came from the store, motor must remain stock.
- The Derby is limited to a 6 or 12 volt Power Wheel only. The stock battery can be replaced with a 12 volt mower battery only.
- The battery can be positioned anywhere inside the car and covered, except the passenger seat.
- Doors and hoods are to be secured so they don't come open.
- Seatbelts are not mandatory, but highly recommended.
- All drivers must wear a helmet.
- Rollover bars will be allowed, as long as, they don't reinforce the power wheel.
- All power wheels must be set up like the manufacturer. No raising or lowering the front or rear of the power wheels.
- Legal Parent or Guardian must register child and sign a waiver. Power Wheels will be inspected before the derby.
